## Postponement Signals



**AP**  
Races not started are *postponed*. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is *postponed* again or *abandoned*.

**AP over H**  
Races not started are *postponed*. Further signals ashore.

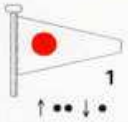

**AP over A**  
Races not started are *postponed*. No more racing today.

**AP over a numeral pennant 1-6** Postponement of 1-6 hours from the scheduled starting time.



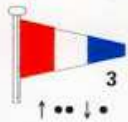

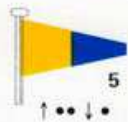

## Abandonment Signals



**N** All races that have started are *abandoned*. Return to the starting area. The warning signal will be made 1 minute after removal unless at that time the race is *abandoned* again or *postponed*.

**N over H**  
All races are *abandoned*. Further signals ashore.

**N over A**  
All races are *abandoned*. No more racing today.

**P** Preparatory signal.

**S** The course has been shortened. Rule 32.2 is in effect.

## Course Change Signals



**C** The position of the next *mark* has been changed:  
-----



to starboard;



to port;



to decrease the length of the leg;



to increase the length of the leg.

## Other Signals



**L** Ashore: A notice to competitors has been posted.

Afloat: Come within hail or follow this boat.



**M** The object displaying this signal replaces a missing *mark*.

**Y** Wear a personal flotation device.

**Blue flag**  
or shape. This race committee boat is in position at the finishing line.

(no sound)

The meanings of visual and sound signals for 2009-2012 are stated above. An arrow pointing up or down (↑ ↓) means that a visual signal is displayed or removed. A dot (•) means a sound; five short dashes (-----) mean repetitive sounds; a long dash (—) means a long sound. When a visual signal is displayed over a class flag, the signal applies only to that class.

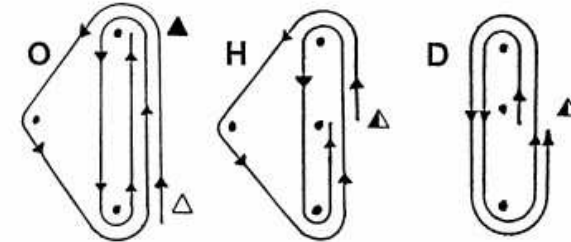
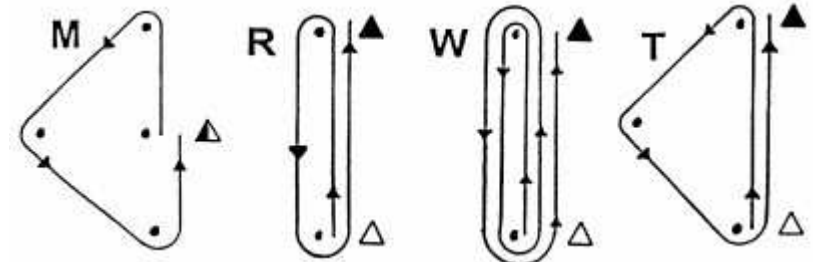
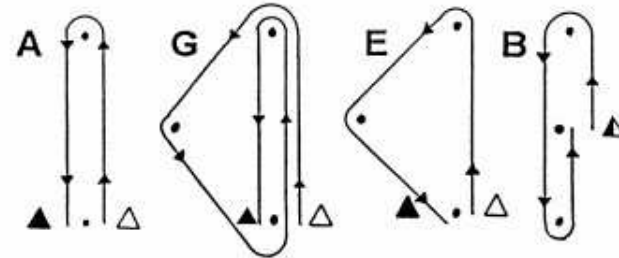

| <b>F</b> G "3" QG Gong at NW end of Breakwater | <b>T</b> C "1" Green Can off Thatcher Island   |
| <b>J</b> G "1" Bell north of Flat Ground       | <b>W</b> Portable inflated windward mark   |
| <b>L</b> G "1" Fl G 2.5s Bell east of Salvages | <b>X</b> Portable inflated mark off Straitsmouth Island - must be honored (stay outside X) |
| <b>P</b> N "2" Red Nun - Pigeon Cove Harbor    |  |
