NOTICE OF RACE and REGISTRATION FORM 2008 FLYING SCOT® NEW ENGLAND DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIP

**June 28-29, 2008 - Registration and welcome starting at 1600 on Friday, June 27, 2008
Hosted by Flying Scot Fleet 11, Sandy Bay Yacht Club, Rockport, Mass.**

- Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by the current edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) with U.S. Sailing Prescriptions, the rules of The Flying Scot class and the regatta sailing instructions. RRS Rules 77 and 78 do not apply.
- Eligibility:** This regatta is open to all members of the Flying Scot Class. Current membership in the Flying Scot Sailing Association (FSSA) is required for all skippers. Applications for Membership in FSSA will be accepted at the regatta registration.
- Registration:** Registration, including those attending for meals only, may be by mail using the forms on the FSSA.COM website or at the regatta site beginning Friday, June 27 at 1600, and Saturday, June 28 at 0700. All registrations must be completed by 0900 on Saturday, June 28
- Measurement:** All boats will be checked for required safety equipment and sail compliance as mandated by the FSSA class rules.
- Fees:** The entry fee is \$110, which includes breakfasts, and dinner on Saturday night for skipper and 1 crew member, for all registrations postmarked by June 9, 2008. Costs for meals only are found on the registration form. Registration after June 9th will be \$135.

- Courses to be Sailed:** The courses to be sailed are illustrated in the regatta sailing instructions.
- Radio Communication:** Boats shall neither make nor receive radio communication while racing. This included mobile phones. Emergency communications are an exception.
- Trophies:** Trophies will be awarded to at least the top 5 skippers and crew. All skippers are eligible for the regatta trophies. New England District perpetual trophies may only be awarded to a member of a FSSA New England District fleet.

Registration - Please complete the attached registration form, make your check payable to Sandy Bay Flying Scot Fleet, and mail them to: **FS NE Districts, c/o David Archibald, 1 Meadowsweet Road, West Newbury, MA 01985**. The registration fee includes launching, parking, Friday welcome party, Saturday and Sunday breakfast for 2 people, Saturday and Sunday lunches for 2 people, Saturday cocktail party, Saturday dinners for 2 people.

Arrival and Launching – The Club will be open on Friday, June 27, 2008, from 1600 until about 2000, and again at 0700 Saturday, for launching your boat with light refreshments served on Friday evening. Trailer parking as well as boat launching are provided on Club grounds. In case of large numbers of trailers they may be stored offsite in Rockport. Some moorings and dock spaces will be provided, and once launched; boats must be left in the water until the end of racing on Sunday.

Accommodations – SBYC members will host out-of-town competitors, as space permits. Bed and Breakfast and Inn vacancies are in short supply in Rockport so reservations should be made early.
