## NOTICE OF RACE and REGISTRATION FORM 2011 FLYING SCOT® NEW ENGLAND DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIP

**August 6, 2011- Registration and welcome starting at 1600 on Friday, August 5, 2011  
Hosted by Flying Scot Fleet 11, Sandy Bay Yacht Club, Rockport, Mass.**

- Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by the current edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) with U.S. Sailing Prescriptions, the rules of The Flying Scot class and the regatta sailing instructions. RRS Rules 77 and 78 do not apply.
- Eligibility:** This regatta is open to all members of the Flying Scot Class. Current membership in the Flying Scot Sailing Association (FSSA) is required for all skippers/helmsmen. Applications for Membership in FSSA will be accepted at the regatta registration.
- Registration:** Register early using the enclosed form, the form found at the yacht club website, or at the regatta site beginning Friday, August 5 at 1600, and Saturday, August 6 at 0700.
- Measurement:** All boats may be checked for required safety equipment and sail compliance as mandated by the FSSA class rules.
- Fees:** The entry fee is \$65, which includes a continental breakfast and a cookout on Saturday night for skipper and crew, for all registrations postmarked by July 31, 2011. Registration after July 31 will be \$75. A bag lunch will be available at an additional cost.
- Schedule:** Multiple races up to a maximum of five races with one race constituting a regatta. A throw-out will be awarded when four more races are completed. Low point scoring will apply. The weather date for the regatta is August 7, 2011.
